The Council of Doctoral Students' Self-Government of the Doctoral School of Social Sciences at the University of Łódź and the Interdisciplinary Scientific Circle of the Doctoral School of Social Sciences at the University of Łódź would like to invite you to participate in the 1st International Doctoral Conference - social sciences in research of young scientists. The conference is addressed to all young researchers preparing doctoral dissertations in the disciplines:

- sociological sciences
- economics and finance
- legal sciences
- pedagogy
- psychology
- socio-economic geography and spatial planning
- Management and quality sciences
- political sciences and administration

The conference has been divided into 2 days of scientific meetings. Each day, in addition to listening to conference presentations, participants will have the opportunity to attend a meeting led by an expert from the chosen discipline. The expert meetings will address general issues concerning the work of each scientist.

In addition, a panel from each discipline will include an expert in that discipline. This will give conference participants the chance to exchange comments and experiences, with an authority from their discipline, outside their home centre.

WHEN?

The conference will take place from 6-7 December 2023 in an online format, on the Microsoft Teams platform.

The length of the Conference and number of panels is dependent on the number of speakers.

WHAT IS THE CONFERENCE ABOUT?

The aim of the 1st International Doctoral Conference - Social Sciences in the Research of Young Scientists, is to present the research of doctoral students interested in the social sciences.



HOW TO PREPARE A SPEECH?

The theme of the presentations should relate to the analysis conducted within one of the disciplines within the scope of social sciences (sociology, economics, political science, law, pedagogy, psychology, socio-economic geography, management sciences). The speech may contain any scope of research - qualitative or quantitative analysis, presentation of the dissertation concept, presentation of research results, including methodological analysis.

In addition, speeches can be interdisciplinary, combining different scientific fields.

We believe in freedom of academic discussion and do not censor presentations for worldview or political reasons. Original and unconventional presentations will always find recognition from the Organising Committee.

FOR WHO?

- Doctoral students preparing their dissertations in Doctoral Schools or pursuing doctoral training in other forms are cordially invited to actively participate in the Conference.
- Passive participation does not require any scientific qualifications.
